SMOKE ALARMS

SHOULD BE TESTED EACH MONTH.

SMOKE ALARM BATTERIES SHOULD BE CHANGED AS NEEDED. (REACH OUT TO YOUR COMMUNITY MANAGER IF YOU NEED ASSISTANCE.)

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

CANDLES SHOULD BE IN STURDY FIRE-PROOF CONTAINERS THAT CAN'T TIP OVER.

ONLY ADULTS SHOULD BLOW OUT CANDLES WHEN LEAVING THE ROOM OR GOING TO BED.

CANDLES SHOULD BE KEPT OUT OF REACH FROM CHILDREN AND PETS

ELECTRICAL & APPLIANCE SAFETY

ALL ELECTRICAL CORDS SHOULD BE IN GOOD CONDITION AND ARE NOT BROKEN OR CUT.

IF YOU HAVE A DRYER IN YOUR APARTMENT HOME, YOU SHOULD CLEAN THE DRYER OF LINE AFTER EVERY USE.

ALL PLUG OUTLETS SHOULD BE SAFE AND SHOULD NOT FEEL WARM WHEN YOU TOUCH THEM (IF THEY ARE WARM, CALL YOUR COMMUNITY MANAGER.)



CHILDREN ARE SOMETIMES CURIOUS ABOUT FIRE.

IF YOU HAVE CHILDREN IN YOUR HOME, LOCK UP ANY ITEMS THAT CAN START A FIRE (MATCHES, LIGHTERS, CIGARETTES, ETC.)

AND MAKE SURE CHILDREN CANNOT REACH CANDLES.

TEST YOUR ALARM REGULARLY

YOUR SMOKE ALARM IS WORKING IF IT MAKES NOISE WHEN YOU PRESS THE "TEST" BUTTON.
